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## **Terms of Adoption**

- 1. **Return:** The adopted dog may be returned to Maine Sheltie Rescue, Inc. within two weeks of the date of adoption for a full refund if the adopter is not satisfied with any aspect of the adoption. After two weeks for the above date, no refund will be given.
- 2. **Transfer of Ownership:** The adopted dog may not be transferred to any other person for any reason. If the undersigned is forced to relinquish custody of the dog at any time, said dog will be relinquished only to Maine Sheltie Rescue, Inc.
- 3. **Refund:** There will be no refund or reimbursement for any expenses incurred by the adopter for the adopted dog, even in the event it is returned to Maine Sheltie Rescue, Inc.
- 4. **Health Program:** The adopted dog will be cared for humanely, including adequate food, shelter, water, and veterinary care and will be licensed in accordance with the laws within the jurisdiction in which he resides. The dog is to be exercised in a fenced yard or on a leash.
- 5. **Reason for Adoption:** The adopted dog is to be kept as a house pet; it shall not be used for medical or any other experimental purpose; it shall not be chained or tied, and it shall not be used for breeding.
- 6. **Loss:** If the adopted dog is lost or stolen, the adopter will notify Maine Sheltie Rescue, Inc. IMMEDIATELY. Our staff has the necessary experience and knowledge in dealing with these types of situations should they arise.
- 7. **Reservation of Rights:** Maine Sheltie Rescue, Inc. reserves the right to enforce this contract in order to protect the welfare of the adopted dog. It is understood that Maine Sheltie Rescue, Inc. may examine and make inquiries about said dog at any time. If the terms and conditions of the Adoption Agreement are not upheld, Maine Sheltie Rescue, Inc. reserves the right to terminate the agreement and to reclaim the dog.
- 8. **Return Check Charge**: There will be a \$25.00 charge on all returned checks submitted by an adopter.

## Other Points to Remember

- Fees: The only fee involved is to cover our expenses. Some of these dogs require extra medical care or special rehabilitation which will entail much greater expense. We do not require, but would appreciate an extra donation to help cover these expenses. The adoption fees will be as follows.
  - Up to age 2: \$400.00
     3 yrs to 7 yrs: \$325.00
  - 3. 8 yrs and over: \$250.00
  - 4. A Senior dog to a senior human (65+) \$150.00
- **Spaying/Neutering:** Some Shelties relinquished to us have already been altered, however, some will be in need of the altering operation. It is a requirement that all Shelties placed for adoption by Maine Sheltie Rescue, Inc. be spayed or neutered.
- Contracts: All adopters of rescue dogs will be asked to sign an Adoption Agreement. This contract is legal and binding. PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY.
- Miscellaneous: We recommend you follow a regular inoculation program established by your veterinarian to guarantee your dog stays healthy. You will receive a complete medical history on your sheltie, as best as can be determined or documented. You must also have the dog licensed in accordance with the laws where you live. Since we do not know you personally, the information for the Adoption Request Questionnaire (which is requested of anyone seeking a rescue sheltie) will help us to match up the right kind of sheltie for your family. We place our shelties only in good, loving homes, and we screen prospective adopters thoroughly.
